

of the find-spots spelt in the same way as on the maps of the enclosed Atlas. Each toponym is followed here by a reference to its location on the respective map of that Atlas. Finally, the Atlas itself comprises a General Survey Map as well as 26 maps of particular sections and 3 Appendix maps, on which the discussed toponyms are located.

One can hardly overestimate the value and utility of that work and further volumes from the projected series are to be welcomed.

It is an excellent initiative of Z. J. Kapera to compile bibliographies of Ancient Cyprus for the years 1969 and 1970—71. In his capacity as a trained librarian he has done a useful service in publishing these very detailed and extensive bibliographies. He has achieved a full historical and archaeological representation including also relevant philological, geographical, and ancient religion and epigraphical items. He has classified the material well and found a suitable system of reference marks. I have found many entries in the bibliographies which would otherwise have escaped my notice. I sincerely hope that the author will publish a continuation and that his „Bibliography of Ancient Cyprus for the Years 1850—1970“ will also be printed one day¹.
