BIBLIOGRAPHY OF ANCIENT CYPRUS
FOR THE YEAR 1974

Cyprus, with its ancient culture, is a bridge between East and West, between Europe, the Middle East and Africa. Its history is inextricably bound with that of ancient Egypt, Palestine, Anatolia, Aegean and above all Greece. Researches on ancient Cyprus has been intensified since the creation of the Republic of Cyprus in 1959.

The main aim of the bibliography is to present achievements in the field by numerous scholars from all over the world. It includes all materials on ancient Cyprus, published in 1974 (the tragical year of Turkish invasion), covering the time from the Neolithic period to Arab raids in the middle of the seventh century A. D.

The bibliography is a continuation of my bibliographies of ancient Cyprus for the years 1969, 1970—1971. Because of unexpected and regrettable delay of the subsequent volumes of the *Studia z archeologii śródziemnomorskiej* (a sub-series of the PRACE ARCHEOLOGICZNE), I have accepted the generous proposal of the President of the Oriental Committee of the Cracow Branch of the Polish Academy of Sciences, Professor T. Lewicki, to print my bibliography in the FOLIA ORIENTALIA.

As the space offered is strictly limited, I had to choose only the most important items. The abbreviations used can be easily interpreted. In cases of doubt, users of the bibliography are invited to check the abbreviations in the *Fasti Archaeologici* or *Nestor*. One-word titles are not as a rule abbreviated. I hope to add an index of authors and geographical names later on.

A considerable part of the materials have been compiled from the collections of the Jagiellonian University Library in Cracow. This was possible thanks to the kind permission of the Director of the Library and the very friendly attitude of the workers of the Subscription and Purchase Department.

I should like to express my deepest thanks to all my friends from Cyprus Research Centre in Nicosia, who have helped me so much with obtaining Cyprus journals, to Professor V. Karageorghis, the Director of the Dept. of Antiquities, Cyprus, who has kindly permitted to reprint a map from his *Annual Report* 1974 here, and to all the authors from different countries of Europe, America and even from Australia who have kindly sent me their off-prints, in this way making my work much easier. In addition, several archaeological museums and institutes have been exchanging publications with me, and I am greatly obliged to them for that.

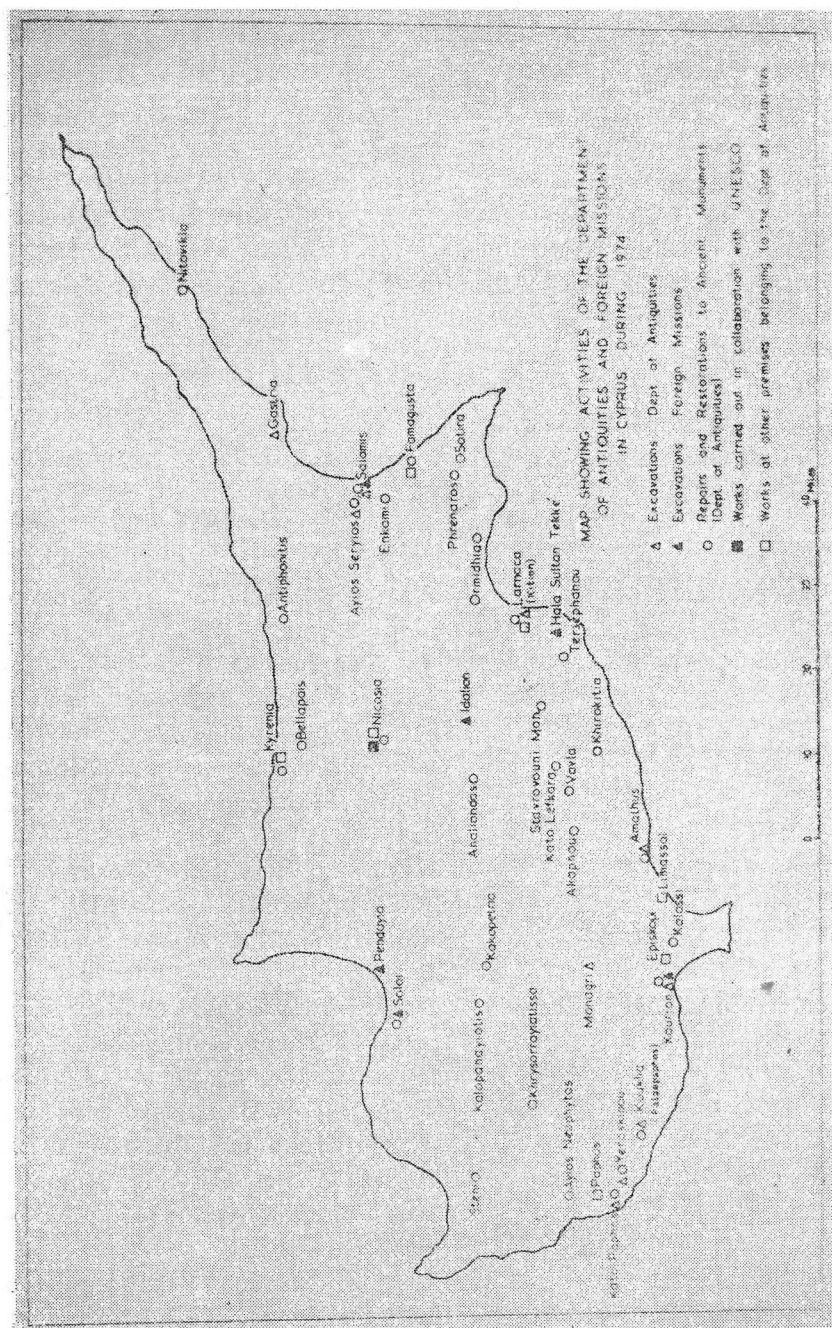
