BIBLIOGRAPHY OF ANCIENT CYPRUS FOR THE YEAR 1977

For some time I have hesitated whether or not to include the subsequent annual bibliography of ancient Cyprus to a special issue of the „Folia Orientalia” in memory of Rev. Prof. Aleksy Klawek. First of all, I should like to mention that he was my Master in Oriental studies at the Jagiellonian University. I had the great pleasure and fortune to take part in his Biblical and Oriental seminary in the academic years 1962/3 till 1967/8. He gave me a deep background to my research in the archaeology and history of Cyprus and Palestine. And I must also say that he discovered my bibliographical passion and invited me to cooperate with the annual „Folia Orientalia”, of which he was then a member of the Editorial Board. So even if the reader will find the inclusion of the present bibliography rather fortuitous, it is, in my opinion, entirely relevant. By publishing this bibliography I should like to honour the Memory of the Men, who was for me not only Master, but also a Sincere Friend.

The main aim of this bibliography is to present new publications on ancient Cyprus. It is a simple continuation of the *Bibliography*

of ancient Cyprus for the year 1974, 1975, 1976¹. Many supplementary items dealing with the proceeding years have been included, and a new map of the archaeological activities of the Department of Antiquities of the Republic of Cyprus and of foreign missions had been added. As in the previous volumes of the „Folia Orientalia”, my space is strictly limited, so I had to choose only the most important items. The abbreviations used can be easily interpreted. In cases of doubt, users of the bibliography are invited to check the abbreviations in the *Fasti Archaeologici* or *Nestor*. One-word titles are not as a rule abbreviated.

The bibliography of ancient Cyprus is addressed to the increasing number of people interested in the archaeology and history of Cyprus. This bibliography would be more detailed and extensive if more scholars would like to cooperate. Cyprological publications appear in very many journals published all over the world and scattering of items is great. What is even more important, many journals come to Cracow too late and sometimes I even note gaps in library collections. This is the reason that I should like to ask all people and institutions interested to send all their publications on ancient Cyprus directly to my home address: Zdzisław J. Kapera, ul. Borsucza 3/58, 30-408 Kraków, Poland. In this way my task would be much easier and the bibliography more useful. Books, journals, and off-prints (even mimeographed materials) would be welcome.

A considerable part of the material have been compiled as usual from the collections of the Jagiellonian University Library in Kraków. This was possible thanks to the really friendly attitude of the head of the Subscription Department, Mrs. Z. Lederowa and of her workers in the Journals Reading Room.

I should like to express my deepest thanks to the Librarian of the Department of Antiquities in Nicosia, Mrs. L. Ieromonachou, who kindly permitted me to compare her recent collection of items on ancient Cyprus (to be published in a future issue of the Report of the Department of Antiquities, Cyprus), which helped me to fill gaps in my current bibliography. In the name of my wife and myself I should like to thank her for her patience in supplying us the necessary publications during our work in the Library of the Department of Antiquities.

Next, we should like to thank M. Touchais, Librarian at the École Française d'Athènes and his assistant, Mrs. N. Contrafourri for their harmonious cooperation during our research in the School's library.

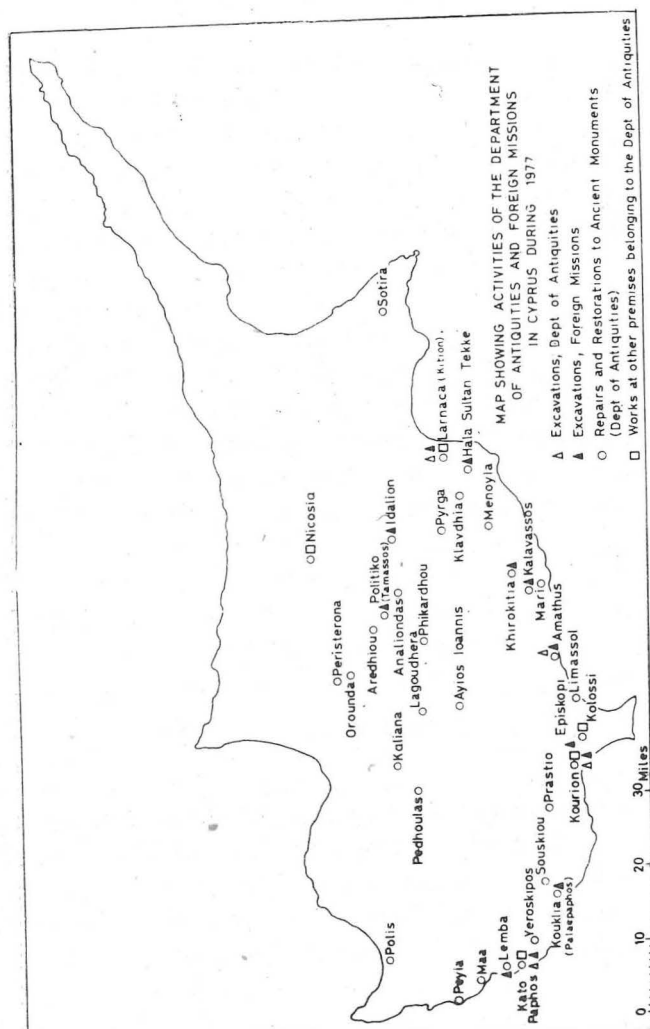

COLLECTANEA THEOLOGICA. Fasciculus specialis [for the year] 1975, 1976, 1977, Varsaviae 1975—1977, Academiae Theologiae Catholicae cura edita, 8°, pp. 194 (+1), 229 (+3), 233 (+3).

For several years the old Polish theological quarterly „Collectanea Theologica” has been appearing in a partly new form. Eventually the unnamed editorial board decided to publish once a year a „Fasciculus specialis”, i.e. a special issue in Congress languages. It contains circa 15 articles on 200—240 pages of text, mostly devoted to theological problems, but there is also some room reserved for Biblical research, too. In general the special issue of the „Collectanea Theologica” will represent to foreign readers „some works of Polish authors representing different theological circles of Poland”.
